

# CONSENT AND ACKNOWLEDGMENTS IN TERMS OF THE PROTECTION OF PERSONAL INFORMATION ACT 2013 (POPI)

## **Consent form for Durban Bible College (DBC)**

#### **Overview**

The Protection of Personal Information Act (POPI) aims to give effect to the constitutional right to privacy by balancing the right to privacy against that of access to information. POPI requires that personal information relating to individuals be processed lawfully and in a reasonable manner that does not infringe on the right to privacy. This consent form sets out how personal information will be collected, used, and protected by DBC, as required by POPI. The use of the words "the individual" for this document shall be a reference to any individual communicating with DBC and/or concluding any agreement, registration, or application, with the inclusion of each individual referred to or included in terms of such agreement, registration, or application.

#### Personal information

The personal information that DBC requires relates to names and surnames, birth dates, identity numbers, passport numbers, demographic information, education information, occupation information, health information, addresses, memberships, personal and work email and contact details.

#### What is the purpose?

DBC is legally obligated to collect, use, and disclose personal information for:

- reporting to various organizations e.g., SARS, CIPC, SAQA, FASSET, PAFA, QCTO, etc.
- evaluate and process applications.
- compiling statistics and various research reports.
- providing personalized communications and complying with the law.

### **Process personal information**

DBC will only collect personal information for the purpose as stated above. Information will be collected in the following manner:

- directly from the individual or a relevant public or equivalent entity.
- from education institutions, training providers, or other service providers that are providing or
- provided the individual with services.
- from our records relating to our previous supply of services or responses to the individual's request for services.

# To whom will personal information be disclosed?

The personal information may be disclosed to other relevant public or other entities on whose behalf we act as intermediaries and other third parties referred to above.
